



Murder Mystery 8 – Death on the track

The Jenkinson Athletics club were have an extraordinary year. Following a special new secret training system, three of their athletes had broken world records. However the authorities had become a little suspicious and officials were sent to check the athletes for banned substances.

Samples were collected from the 32 athletes at the club and parcelled up ready to be sent to the lab. The samples never made it. Nor did the officials whose bodies were found buried in the long jump pit.

Police have launched a murder investigation and have been given 5 clues and a word grid. Each of the clues picks out 5 or 6 words from the word grid to give information.

Clue 1 involves drawing triangles which pick out 5 words. Clues 2-5 give 2 digit numbers. These 2 digit number need to be split into coordinates and then used to select a word from the grid. So an answer 12 would become (1,2) which would give the word steward.
